The 1st House

The 1st House describes you, your self-expression and vitality. It is your physical appearance and the way others see you and interact with you. The 1st House cusp is, in most cases, the Ascendant or Rising Sign of your chart and indicates your primary motivation in life. The house placement of your 1st House ruler, or almuten, shows the areas of life that are of primary importance to you. Also, planets in your 1st House influence how you present yourself to the world.

Ascendant in Aquarius

Your primary motivation in life is to have freedom of action and movement. You have a modern, contemporary and progressive outlook on life, with an enthusiasm for the new, the unusual and the innovative. You have an individual and original personality yet, at times, can be unconventional, eccentric or unpredictable. Others are attracted to you because you are friendly and interested in people. You are accustomed to a lot of change and variety in your day-to-day life.

1st House Cusp Ruler, Uranus, in 6th House

Aspects to Ascendant

Ascendant Square Moon (6° 37' A)

Ascendant Trine Venus (4° 48' A)

Midpoints to Ascendant

Strained family dynamics. Displays of irritability and intolerance within relationships. Adjusting to partnerships requirements. Sporadic contacts.

Ascendant = Mars/Jupiter (-0° 17' S)

Self-confidence and self-motivation. An enthusiastic and adventurous personality. Taking pride in personal achievements. An enterprising and decisive nature; constructive initiatives. Foresight; the ability to take charge of situations. Recognizing the 'right' moment to take action. Industrious and productive environments. Successful and lucrative partnerships.

Ascendant = Mercury/Mars (+0°28' A d)

A competitive nature. High motivation and ambition. An excellent net-worker; multi-skilled. Alert, attentive and 'quick off the mark'. Assessing situations and knowing what to do in most instances. Taking charge of the environment. Verbally forthright and aggressive; speaking one's mind. An assertive and at times abrasive manner. Friction within the environment. Impatience. Accident proneness.

Ascendant = Venus/Saturn (+1°34' A)

An emotionally reserved and aloof nature. Gradually and patiently establishing intimate connections. Older or mature partners. The desire for trust and respect within partnerships. The 2nd House

The 2nd House is associated with personal assets and financial affairs. It governs all moveable possessions and wealth.

2nd House Cusp in Aries

Aspects to Moon

Moon Sextile Mercury (1° 15' S)

Moon Trine Jupiter (2°46' S)

You know how to enjoy yourself and are fond of sociable and pleasurable activities. Relations with women are usually positive.

Moon Square Pluto (3°21' A)

You have a complex emotional life. Your feelings are intense and you feel things deeply. The dynamics of your personal relationships are intricate and often strained, especially with your family or significant females. There are power struggles in the home or with dominant women. Equally, you can be domineering or emotionally manipulative and intent on getting everything your own way. You can also be prone to particular habitual fixations or compulsions.

Moon Square Moon's North Node (6°19' S)

Difficulties with others can arise through a lack of adaptability or insensitivity, leading to estrangements or parting company.

Moon Opposition Midheaven (2°27' S)

Midpoints to Moon

Moon = Moon's North Node/Midheaven (-1°56' A)

Connecting with people who can influence and assist in the realization of goals

and objectives. Supporting others and being supported in personal and professional interests. Sensitive and receptive to the needs and aspirations of others. Instinctively cultivating an inner connection within relationships. A close-knit family unit. Professional and emotional ties with women.

Moon = Pluto/Ascendant (-1° 38' A d)

A magnetic and dynamic personality. Compulsive tendencies; the need to feel in control of personal surroundings. Obsessive about family and domestic concerns. Fixations and dependencies. Sensing potential threats or negative energies in the environment. Emotional manipulation within partnerships. Power struggles within relationships.

Moon = Mercury/Venus (-1° 32' S)

An affectionate and caring nature; attentive and sensitive to the needs of others. A talent for art, language and writing. Being drawn to that which appeals to the eye, senses and emotions. The need to be involved in creative expression and dialogues. Discussing intimate relationship details with others. A creative family. Hospitable and entertaining. Social awareness.

Moon = Pluto/Moon's North Node (-1° 29' S)

Profound emotional experiences. Intensity of feeling in relationships. Power struggles in partnerships and within family dynamics. Manipulation and control. Subjection to family and cultural pressures. Participating in public or mass gatherings. Influential and domineering women.

Moon = Sun/Mars (-1° 03' S)

A self-motivated individual who gets results. Acting as a protector and provider - hard working and productive. A dominant figure in domestic, family and relationship affairs. Taking care of others and taking charge of situations. Marriage and procreation. Emotional reactions to conflict, aggressive energy or pushiness.

Moon = Venus/Neptune (+1° 35' A)

Emotional sensitivity. A soft-hearted and sentimental nature. A giving, supportive and loving person. The need to care for others and to feel cared for. Enjoying and being emotionally uplifted by beauty, art and music. Romantic idealism. Wishful and hopeful in love. Sexual infatuations. Relationship disappointments. The potential for deceiving others - and being deceived.

The 4th House

The 4th House is associated with home and family matters. It describes your parents - especially the father - and your relationship with them. It gives information on your family history or ancestry and the nature of your later life. Real estate and property belong here.

4th House Cusp in Gemini

Learning is encouraged in the home. Family members are open with each other and generally communicate frankly with one another. It is possible that you, or your family, maintain more than one place of residence. Your retirement years will be stimulating and active.

4th House Cusp Ruler, Mercury, in 6th House

The 5th House

The 5th House is associated with pleasure, sex, love affairs and children. It also governs artistic creativity, music, the fine arts, fashion, social entertainment, games and speculations.

5th House Cusp in Cancer

You have an emotional attitude towards love. You may be prone to sentimentality. You need to be aware that too much feeling in love could smother another. You like the taste and smell of food and enjoy eating and drinking. Recreational sporting activities may include water sports, such as swimming, sailing or even skiing.

5th House Cusp Ruler, Moon, in 3rd House

You may have knowledge of the arts, sports or the markets and people may ask your opinions on them. You know how to promote your creative endeavors and

express any artistic abilities you may possess. Communication in love and relationships is important to you. You may teach or be involved with children, as you know how to get through to them.

Venus in 5th House

You have a strongly romantic nature and will probably experience many affairs of the heart. You know how to live and how to enjoy life's pleasures. You are easy-going, popular and well-liked. Other people are attracted to you for your infectious sense of fun. Children, in particular, find you easy to get along with. You appreciate the arts, and are probably artistically talented in some form of creative expression, especially acting, dancing, music or singing.

Venus in Cancer

You experience deep and sincere feelings of love and are caring and protective towards your loved ones. To feel emotionally secure, you need to have affection and tenderness demonstrated. Aspects to Venus

Venus Quincunx Jupiter (0°57' S)

Even the 'difficult' aspects, such as this, between Venus and Jupiter are not as challenging as other planetary combinations. They are, after all, the so-called benefic planets and they tend to work well together. At worst, there can be a tendency towards negligence and laziness, or over-indulgence and wastefulness. To some extent, life's advantages can come too easily to you, resulting in a tendency to take things for granted. Still, this is a very desirable aspect to have in your chart because it brings social and worldly benefits and facilitates successful relationships with others. Romantic encounters are generally positive and happy, and artistic ability is evident. Positively, you have a pleasant and affectionate nature, which warms people to you easily. Gregarious and optimistic, you embrace life wholeheartedly and fully. You have an attractive personality and a kind-hearted manner about you, with the ability to gain popularity or favoritism from others.

Venus Sextile Moon's North Node (4°30' S)

Midpoints to Venus

Venus = Saturn/Midheaven (-1°07' A d)

Working hard to attain what is wanted and desired in life. The desire for trust and loyalty in partnerships. Making sacrifices in and for love. Achieving creative recognition through persistence and discipline. Feeling awkward and self-conscious; difficulties expressing intimate feelings and affections. Repressed emotional and sexual desires. An innate fear of failure. Emotional distress caused by loss or separation. Heartache.

Venus = Saturn/Pluto (-0°40' S)

Appreciating simplicity; leading a spartan existence. Understated displays of affection. Triumphs and knock-backs in love - and in life. Loyalty and commitment within partnerships. Difficulties through a lack of tolerance and compromise. Repressed emotional and sexual desires. Contending with extreme pressure within relationships. Controlling others or being controlled. A decisive separation.

Venus = Uranus/Neptune (+0°08' A)

Sudden changes of heart. The tendency to be carried away by romantic notions and wishes; a person who is easily influenced and swayed emotionally and sexually. Confusion and disorientation. A chaotic love and sex life. Disappointment and instability within love and partnership. Creative vision. Sudden artistic inspiration. Enjoying alternative or progressive art forms.

Venus = Moon/Jupiter (+0°26' S)

A loving, supportive and generous nature. Finding emotional happiness with another. Harmonious and successful relationships. Family, social and material benefits. The desire for emotional and financial security. Personal satisfaction and contentment. Artistic appreciation and talent; creative and enterprising. Productive and fertile activity. Extravagance and indulgence.

Venus = Neptune/Ascendant (+1°00' S d)

An alluring and elusive personality. Sensitive and susceptible to environmental influences. Being easily swayed or seduced by another. Misdirected desires and

affections. Deception within love and sex relationships. Disenchantment. Creative inspiration. The act of pretending in order to gain acceptance or favour - acting ability. Cravings and addictions.

Venus = Neptune/Moon's North Node (+1°09' A)

Idealistic expectations in love and partnership. Emotional sensitivity and empathy within relationships. Sentimentality. Romantic notions about love unions. Infatuations; idolizing others. Feeling at ease in the company of creative and artistic people. Spiritual connections. Misdirected passions. Deceiving another or being deceived by loved ones. Partnership disappointments.

Venus = Moon/Mercury (+1°11' S d)

Feeling young at heart. A caring and giving nature. Attentive and perceptive; sensitive to the thoughts and wishes of others. Knowing what pleases people. Discussing intimate feelings. Love dialogues and conversations. Artistic talent and appreciation. Beauty and refinement. Social connections and contacts.

Venus = Jupiter/Midheaven (+1°39' S d)

Embracing life whole-heartedly. Appreciating what life has to offer. Good fortune in love and partnership. Opportunities to advance personal aspirations and desires. Prospering materially and socially. Attaining status, artistic recognition or professional success. Satisfying personal desires. Expensive and extravagant tastes.

The 6th House

The 6th House is associated with work and employment or service. It describes your dependents such as pets, employees, servants and tenants if you have any. It is the house of health and sickness. It governs doctors, nurses and dentists.

6th House Cusp in Cancer

You need to feel emotionally involved in your work for it to have any real meaning for you. You also need to feel a sense of security regarding your work, as uncertainty surrounding a job can affect your health and general feeling of well-being. You enjoy being of service to others and any job in fields such as catering, the health sector, nutritional guidance, home care or civic responsibility could be personally satisfying.

6th House Cusp Ruler, Moon, in 3rd House

It is likely that your work involves some branch of the communication industry. You may be involved in telecommunications, broadcasting, the media, journalism or magazine work. Alternatively, your work may entail a high level of mobility and commuting. You may work in conjunction with a relative or sibling.

Mercury in 6th House

You are a hard worker; however you need to pace yourself well, in order to avoid stress-related illnesses. Mercury in Leo

You are a self-assured communicator and a strong-minded person with firm convictions and fixed opinions. Aspects to Mercury

Mercury Opposition Jupiter (1°31' S)

You are basically an optimist at heart and usually express a positive and confident outlook on life. In your desire to broaden your knowledge, you will most likely travel, correspond with people in other countries and possibly study or have business arrangements overseas. You may be well read and erudite. Certainly, you appreciate the value and benefits of a sound education. Possibly, you may have a tendency to be absent-minded, or inclined to overlook important details. Poor judgment or sloppy thinking can lead to problems with investments, contracts or legal documents. At times, you may be intellectually arrogant, preachy or prone to exaggeration.

Mercury Opposition Saturn (7°03' S)

speech, logical in your approach to things and methodical in your working habits. You have excellent powers of concentration and can succeed with academic study or research work. However, you can be prone to bouts of self-doubt regarding your mental abilities, which can restrict your educational achievements. Mercury Square Neptune (6° 14' A)

Knowing what is required to make dreams and wishes a reality; understanding the necessity for sacrifices. Ideas and ideals that need to be tempered and grounded. A proneness to self-doubt and defeatist attitudes. Unfounded anxiety; imagining things are worse than they really are. Debilitating pessimism.

Mercury = Moon/Venus (+0° 21' S)

Intellectual receptivity and creativity. An instinctive visual and aesthetic sense. Feeling blessed and acknowledging it. Affectionate responses. Pondering the nature of love. Discussing intimate feelings with others. Talking about relationship and sexual needs and desires; speaking with heart and soul. Thinking about parenthood. Communication with women and family members.

Mercury = Venus/Midheaven (+1°34' S)

Creative or artistic professions. Diplomatic and articulate. Thinking and speaking from the heart. Artistic ideas and aspirations. Decisions based on personal tastes and preferences. Knowing what is wanted in love and personal relationships. The desire for true love and understanding with another. A stimulating and aesthetic home life.

Mercury = Sun/Saturn (+1°35' A)

A disciplined mind. Applying self to serious study and research. Concentration and focus. Logic and reason. Succinct in speech and writing. Single-minded. The tendency to view life seriously and realistically. A practical philosopher. A slow accomplishment of goals. Perseverance. A risk of health problems through poor dietary habits and neglect. Shyness and reticence. Skepticism. A negative outlook. Sober and somber realizations. Mental blocks.

Sun in 6th House

Work matters are always important to you. You achieve recognition in life through developing and expressing specific skills and expertise. You like routine and consistency in your work and are suited to employment in the service industries. You like to be of service to others; however you need to guard against being taken advantage of or exploited. Maintaining a healthy diet and lifestyle is important to you, as your vitality levels can fluctuate. An interest in health and hygiene may incline you to medical work.

Sun in Leo

A solitary disposition. Inclination to stand apart or in isolation. Reclusive tendencies. Difficulty integrating with others. Expressing or experiencing negative attitudes in company. Taking on positions of responsibility in the community or family. Earning the respect of other people. Contacts with serious and experienced people. Estrangements and separations.

Sun = Venus/Mars (-0°22' S d)

Power of attraction. Sexual magnetism. Sensuality. Passionate nature. Ardent in love. Strong desire for sexual experiences and physical and emotional unions. Lust. Adventures in love. The urge to become a parent. Creative flair - artistic skill or appreciation.

Sun = Jupiter/Uranus (+0°30' A)

An adventurous and optimistic spirit. A contemporary outlook. An innovative and original mind. An eagerness for new and stimulating experiences. Resourceful and mentally flexible. Sudden opportunities and successes. Applying new ideas

and techniques successfully. Intuitiveness. Progressive leadership.

Sun = Mercury/Uranus (+1°15' S d)

Original and intuitive thinking. A quick learner with the ability to sum up situations quickly. Intellectual flexibility. Mentally alert and astute. Thinking outside of the box. An interest in reforms and innovations. Open to new and progressive ideas or methods. Restless. Easily distracted. Impulsive and contradictory. Nervous energy.

Sun = Jupiter/Ascendant (+1°22' S d)

Making a good impression on others. Self-confident and self-promoting. A generous spirit. Furthering personal interests. The ability to get ahead in life and to come into contact with successful and prominent people. Happy and profitable relationships. Affluent connections. A positive and healthy outlook on life.

Sun = Jupiter/Moon's North Node (+1°31' A)

Ease of self-expression in the company of others. Capability to readily integrate and to be a vital member of a group or association. Alliances which further personal objectives. Advantageous and pro-active connections. Contact with achievers. Fortunate partnerships. Intellectual associations. Academic, philosophical and foreign contacts.

Sun = Moon/Saturn (+1°54' S)

Self-reliant and self-sufficient. Feelings of isolation or standing alone in life. Necessity to take responsibility for self and actions. Testing personal and family circumstances. Emotional or physical separations. Recycling periods of low self-confidence or self-motivation.

Uranus in 6th House

You do not like to be tied down to strict routines in your work. You look for employment in fields that offer a fair amount of change and variety, coupled with a measure of autonomy, as you tend not to conform easily to the authority of others. You are suited to work that incorporates modern working methods and up-to-date technology. In regard to matters of health, you tend to be attracted to non-traditional healing techniques.

Uranus in Leo

You are a member of a generation that strives to be different and independent.

You insist on individual freedom and will rebel against authority. Boldly enterprising, you will take risks. You can be obstinate, self-willed or uncompromising.

Aspects to Uranus

Uranus Quincunx Saturn (0°03' A)

You often feel tense and churned up inside, as you struggle between the urge to conform and the urge to assert your individuality. One side of you wants to be like everyone else while the other side cannot bear the thought of it. Also, when you feel the pressure for change building up within you, don't suppress it because you may cause yourself stress and even possible physical injury. For your own peace of mind you need to find a balance between these conflicting urges. You are quite rebellious and will buck against anyone or anything that restricts your freedom.

Uranus Conjunct Moon's North Node (2°02' A)

You either prefer the company of unusual and original people, or you come across to others as unconventional and eccentric yourself. Midpoints to Uranus

Intense frustration. Coping under duress. Exposure to volatile, challenging and perilous influences. The state of being caught off-guard or suddenly disadvantaged. Defense and attack. Hostile actions; aggravating and debilitating circumstances. Angst. Decisive separations. The experience of loss and grief.

Uranus = Sun/Midheaven (-0°57' A)

An intuitive awareness of goals. Individualized aims and aspirations. The motivation to accomplish unique objectives in life. Experimentation; trying new things. Forward-thinking and progressive initiatives. A busy and, at times, stressful professional life. Unexpected incidents. Changeable or unstable domestic and vocational circumstances.

Uranus = Sun/Pluto (-0° 30' A d)

An extremely independent and self-willed individual. Self-exploration; discovering new frontiers of personal challenge. Channeling creative energy into pioneering ventures. Breaking new ground. The compulsion to reorganize personal circumstances. Manipulative influences. Defiance. Problems through extreme and erratic behavior.

Uranus = Mars/Jupiter (+1° 27' S)

An intuitive sense of timing. Trusting own judgment - having faith in personal abilities. An entrepreneurial spirit. Successfully implementing new methods or techniques. Taking calculated risks. High motivation. Decisive action. Independent and ambitious initiatives. The desire to run one's own business or to act in a freelance capacity.

Uranus = Moon's North Node/Ascendant (+1° 53' S)

Stimulating personal connections. Associating with progressive - or eccentric individuals. Cultivating ties with people from all walks of life. Changeable elements within the personal or family-circle. Adapting or reacting to disruptive environmental influences. Unpredictability within associations. Stressful relationships.

The 7th House

The 7th House is associated with partnerships, both personal and professional. It rules your relationship with other people generally, including those who oppose you. It also describes the sort of person you will attract as a mate.

7th House Cusp in Leo

You attract, or are attracted to, a partner who can provide you with the good things in life and who is also generous and warm-hearted. You need to be with someone that you can respect and feel proud to be with. Loyalty and devotion is also expected from a partner and others. You need to guard against bossiness and stubbornness in relationships.

The outcome of this house is determined by the placement of its ruler.

7th House Cusp Ruler, Sun, in 6th House

You may meet partners through work, or work together in business. The seventh house also represents opponents, therefore it is possible that you could

experience disputes or conflicts with work colleagues, or employees if you are an employer.

Moon's North Node in 7th House

Your karmic lesson in life is to experience and learn about relationships. Partnerships, both personal and professional, can feature strongly in your life.

Moon's North Node in Leo

You demonstrate self-confidence and self-assuredness in the company of other people. You often assume the role of leader and organizer in group activities. Other people will look to you for guidance. You are socially active, fun-loving, entertaining, and like sharing in festive events and social occasions.

Aspects to Moon's North Node

Moon's North Node Quincunx Saturn (1° 59' S)

It is very likely that you'll establish unions with others of a wide-age difference to yourself. Older people play an important role in your early life. You are attracted to them for their knowledge, wisdom and experience. You have a sense of responsibility towards others, coupled with strong feelings of loyalty and duty. At times, other people's actions can sadden or depress you. And, in some cases, there are people who can oppress you and make you feel bitter and frustrated.

Midpoints to Moon's North Node

Moon's North Node = Uranus/Ascendant (-1° 10' A)

An assertive personality. Connecting with progressive and independent people; advocates for change and reform. Activists. Group involvement in collective causes and issues. Demonstrating a united front. Thriving on stimulation within partnerships. Adjusting to shifts and changes within relationships - and within the environment.

Moon's North Node = Mars/Jupiter (-0° 35' A)

Connecting with creative and highly motivated people. Achieving the desired results in enterprises through combined effort and endeavor. Prosperous partnerships. Profitable and rewarding associations. Business activity; lucrative

deals and investments with others. Fertile relationships.

Moon's North Node = Mercury/Mars (+0°11' S d)

Lively and heated discussions with others. Brain-storming sessions within associations. Taking an active interest in people's opinions or points of view. Letting one's intentions be known. Irritability and intolerance within relationships. Arguments and disagreements.

Moon's North Node = Venus/Saturn (+1°16' S)

Contending with commitment issues in love. Making sincere sacrifices for loved ones. A loyal friend or companion. Difficulty establishing intimate relationships. Emotional and sexual restraint between partners. Despondency and jealousy. Separative influences.

Pluto in 7th House

Personal and professional relationships tend to be intense experiences for both yourself and partners. You have a tendency to push partnerships to the limit, and to place great emotional pressure and demands on others. Power struggles are likely in your relationships, and issues of dominance and manipulation may need to be addressed. Under certain conditions, there can be disputes with powerful adversaries.

Pluto in Virgo

You are a member of a generation who experiences extraordinary pressures and upheavals in the areas of employment and health. You are exposed to transformations within the work and health sectors that occur outside of your own control. You witness breakthroughs in medical science, coupled with a rise of interest in alternative therapies.

Aspects to Pluto

Pluto Sextile Neptune (1°38' A)

Neptune and Pluto are the solar system's slowest moving planets; consequently aspects between them last for a great number of years and their effects are less personal than collective. Since 1940 and continuing until about 2040 they are in sextile aspect to each other. The major effect of this is to accentuate spiritual awareness and development en masse. You are part of a generation that is

intent on exploring and refining the inner aspect of life and consciousness itself. You will be aware of a universal interest in metaphysical subjects, clairvoyance and psychical research.

Pluto Square Midheaven (0° 54' A)

You have the capability to make your mark on the world and become a person of some significance or importance. If other factors in your horoscope support it, you have the potential to gain a measure of fame. At some point in your life, there is a strong possibility you will undergo a radical change in direction that may surprise both yourself and others. Midpoints to Pluto

Pluto = Sun/Venus (+0° 13' S)

The desire for commitment in love and in partnership - deep and meaningful relationships. Drama and intensity in love life. Difficulties through possessiveness and obsessiveness.

Mars in 7th House

You are drawn to active, energetic and enthusiastic people. You like to take part in team activities or projects together with a partner. Direct and competitive in your relationships, you need a partner that you can spar with. Quarrels and disagreements are frequent in your personal unions. Other people can annoy or irritate you if they interfere in your life, or insist on organizing you against your will. You are outgoing and sociable and tend to make and break contacts quickly and impulsively.

Mars in Virgo

Your goals and actions are usually practical and useful. You are economical in the expenditure of energy. Precise and exacting, you are motivated to do the best you can at any task. You approach projects in a logical and methodical manner. You are intolerant of sloppiness and untidiness in the work environment. You tend to get angry or irritable when routines are upset or things don't go to

Aspects to Mars

Mars Trine Saturn (2°44' A)

You are a hard worker and have the power to realize your objectives through perseverance and determination. You are good at physical and manual work, or activities requiring self-discipline and stamina such as endurance sports. In stressful or dangerous situations, you can be counted on to keep a clear and cool head.

Mars SemiSquare Neptune (1°01' A)

The main challenge of this aspect is to discover how to channel your energies most effectively. This is difficult because Neptune tends to undermine Mars' ability to act by dissipating its power, or causing it to express itself in a chaotic or immoral way. Physically, the body's defenses can be weakened causing a susceptibility to infections and viruses. For creative people, this pairing can produce talents in music, visual arts, theater, film, photography or fashion. Mars = Sun/Mercury (-0°07' A)

Intellectually sharp and clever. Planning and pursuing clear objectives. Tactical skill in competitive situations - thriving on challenge. Asserting personal view points. Jumping to conclusions. Recognizing danger and knowing how and when to act. Impulsive thoughts and actions. Verbally aggressive and argumentative. Retaliation. Accidents through a lack of concentration. Quick actions and reactions.

The 8th House

The 8th House is the house of shared resources, other people's money, including the partner's. It is associated with wills, inheritances, death and loss.

8th House Cusp in Libra

You insist on fair dealings with regard to joint resources or finances. Always preferring harmony, you do not like to witness people fighting over money and possessions. A partner may be inclined to spend money on beautiful things and pleasure activities.

The outcome of this house is determined by the placement of its ruler.

8th House Cusp Ruler, Venus, in 5th House

Money you receive from such things as inheritances or tax refunds is likely to be spent on things that you enjoy. You may have a talent for encouraging others to spend money on you.

The 9th House

The 9th House is associated with philosophy, wisdom, spirituality, religion, higher education and travel. It also rules those you seek for advice such as lawyers, priests and astrologers.

9th House Cusp in Scorpio

You are deeply attracted to the mystical or occult aspects of religion. You are passionate about learning and have good investigative and research capabilities. In legal disputes, you are a force to be reckoned with, as you have high levels of endurance and tenacity. There is a possibility you could become over-zealous in regard to your convictions or beliefs. Important teachers and advisers tend to be deep and intense, but also can be hyper-critical and unforgiving when wronged.

The outcome of this house is determined by the placement of its ruler.

9th House Cusp Ruler, Pluto, in 7th House

Traveling abroad or pursuing tertiary education could bring you into contact with

a future partner. In your personal relationships, you seek partners who share similar beliefs or philosophies as you.

Neptune in 9th House

You may be attracted to the mystical and ritualistic aspects of spiritual teachings. As a seeker of truth, you may come to realize that ultimate truth is undefinable. You may become devoted to a spiritual leader at some point in your life; however you need to discriminate between true teachers and false prophets. You have to approach all legal matters cautiously, as there could be exposure to fraud or dishonesty. Long-distance travel is likely.

Neptune in Scorpio

Aspects to Neptune

Neptune Square Jupiter (7° 45' S)

You are a selfless and compassionate person who is receptive to the needs of others. Spiritual subjects interest you greatly and it is possible that you possess psychic ability. You have a great amount of imagination and inspiration, which you may effectively channel into creative expressions such as music, theater, dance, film or painting. You are essentially an idealist who sometimes sees the world through rose-tinted glasses. As a result, you can perceive situations to be quite different to what they are in reality. On a mundane level, you may have an enthusiasm for gambling and risk-taking; however it is impossible to tell if your speculations will succeed or fail - so you need to take care, especially if you cannot afford to lose.

Midpoints to Neptune

Neptune = Sun/Jupiter (-1° 54' A d)

Believing that anything is possible in life - high hopes and wishes. The need to keep expectations in perspective. Spiritual, religious or metaphysical interests. Development of the inner life. A risk of misplaced confidence and trust. Potential

health problems through over-indulgence. The weakening of vitality through the overuse of intoxicants and stimulants. Depleted finances; over expenditure.

Neptune = Sun/Mercury (-1°08' A)

Inspired thinking and activity. Creative vision. A highly developed imaginative sense - an interest in music, lyrics, photography, creative writing, etc. A mind searching for spiritual answers. The tendency to lack clarity, discrimination and mental focus. Clouded judgment. Delusional traits. A sensitive nervous system.

The 10th House

The 10th House is associated with your status in the world. It describes your reputation and level of public success. It is the house of career and, traditionally, the house of the mother. In most cases, your 10th House cusp is at the Midheaven.

10th House Cusp in Sagittarius

You may build your reputation upon the acquisition of knowledge and wisdom. Professionally, you may be suited to careers within the legal, education, travel and publishing sectors, or even theology. Your career could involve a lot of mobility and traveling.

The outcome of this house is determined by the placement of its ruler.

10th House Cusp Ruler, Jupiter, in 12th House

You may have some difficulty achieving recognition in your profession. You are a backroom person, content with working behind-the-scenes. You may work with the needy, study the unconscious or work in institutions such as hospitals, hospices, prisons or retreats.

Midpoints to Midheaven

Midheaven = Venus/Neptune (-0°52' S)

Professional idealism. Creative careers. Dreaming of the ideal partner or lover. Soft-hearted and sentimental. Infatuations and longings. A secret affair or relationship. Unrealistic expectations in love and sex. Seducing another or being seduced. Vulnerability. The hiding of one's true feelings for fear of being hurt.

Addictive tendencies.

Midheaven = Moon/Pluto (-0° 46' S)

An emotionally intense nature; the tendency to become fixated or obsessed by something or someone. Extreme ambition - personally and professionally. Dramas and power struggles in domestic and family life - and within career. Ruthless inclinations. Manipulating others and being manipulated. High-powered and domineering women.

Midheaven = Sun/Venus (+1° 07' A)

A loving and devoted nature. Inner harmony. Attractive and magnetic qualities. Appreciating the beautiful things in life. Sociability; mixing with creative people - artists or musicians. Artistic talent and aspirations. Enjoying one's vocation in life - 'loving what you do'. Professional acknowledgement and admiration. Partnerships based on mutual love and respect.

The 11th House

The 11th House is traditionally known as "the house of good fortune". Your friends and benefactors are described here, as well as your hopes and wishes.

11th House Cusp in Capricorn

Your friends and supporters in life tend to be loyal, dependable and industrious. Likewise, you respect your friends and honor them with your trust. You appreciate a responsible and disciplined attitude in others. Older or socially established people may play an important role in your life, as companions or benefactors.

The outcome of this house is determined by the placement of its ruler.

11th House Cusp Ruler, Saturn, in 11th House

You are quite a social person and will most likely meet your friends in common interest groups or clubs. Friendship is extremely important to you. You also know how to cultivate advantageous contacts, which can assist you to realize your hopes and ambitions. You could support a political party at some stage in your life.

Saturn in Capricorn

Your will is strong and unyielding. Ambitious for power, status and authority, you tend to measure your self-worth through how satisfied you are with your personal achievements. You are self-disciplined, practical, frugal and aware of your responsibilities.

Aspects to Saturn

Saturn Conjunct Jupiter (5°32' A)

Contending with obstructive and aggravating conditions. Thwarted plans and intentions. Blocked energy. Aggressive tendencies; hostile actions. Severity. Accident proneness.

Saturn = Mars/Ascendant (-0°32' A)

Recognizing the necessity to take responsibility for self and personal actions. Doing what needs to be done out of duty or loyalty. Resenting restrictive influences and people. Becoming frustrated when prevented from following own initiatives. A repressed personality. Reacting against inhibiting influences within the personal environment - and partnerships. Saturn = Mars/Moon's North Node (-0°23' A)

Consolidating relationships in order to achieve shared goals. Focused activity and disciplined teamwork. Controlling others or being controlled. Clashes of will

and ego. Defensive and reactive inclinations within associations. Conflict within partnerships. Decisive separations. Shared problems and grievances.

The 12th House

The 12th House is the house of ill luck. It is associated with sorrow and sadness, your self-undoing and downfall, as well as your secrets, worries and anxieties. It rules hospitals, hospices, retreats, hideaways and prisons.

12th House Cusp in Capricorn

Controlling others, harboring suspicions or acting selfishly can lead to their enmity. Worry and anxiety can limit your productivity and effectiveness at work. Keeping busy with practical activities in seclusion can be beneficial.

The outcome of this house is determined by the placement of its ruler.

12th House Cusp Ruler, Saturn, in 11th House

You tend to keep your personal goals and ambitions to yourself and only let others know about them on a need-to-know basis. You could find yourself in the role of confidant to important people.

Jupiter in 12th House

You have a humble and somewhat sacrificing nature and enjoy being of service to those in need. You may involve yourself with charity or volunteer work. Successes are possible through involvement with large institutions such as hospitals, universities or churches. Periods of solitude and seclusion from others can rejuvenate you.

Jupiter in Aquarius

You have an impartial and unprejudiced nature, with a strong social sense. Jupiter = Venus/Ascendant (-1°27' A)

An attractive and popular personality. Personal charm and appeal. Enjoying an active social life. Mixing with the 'in crowd'. Affluent ties and connections. Aesthetic and tasteful environments. Moving within artistic and creative circles. Loving and generous partnerships. Extravagance and indulgence. Vanity. Pampering or being pampered. Material acquisitions.

Jupiter = Venus/Moon's North Node (-1°18' A d)

Enjoying social interactions. Successfully gaining the affection of others. Feeling at ease in the company of other people. Giving and receiving within relationships; beneficial ties. Valuing and appreciating intimate connections. Trust and intimacy within love partnerships. Moving in artistic circles. Celebrations within the family.

Jupiter = Mars/Pluto (-1°04' A)

The power of intent and accomplishment. Directing energies into expansion, development and improvement. Large-scale and long term projects. Material and financial investments. Taking effective measures to ensure success. Covering all bases. Relentless drive and determination. Fanaticism. Productive and resourceful. The potential for significant achievements.

Jupiter = Saturn/Neptune (+1°07' S)

Heightened physical and emotional sensitivity. Easily overwhelmed; susceptible to exhaustion and bouts of low of vitality. The gradual undermining of general health and well-being. Fluctuating levels of optimism. Benefits from periodic solitude. Meditation - spiritual retreat. Faith and devotion. Willingly making sacrifices for others. Religiosity and asceticism.

Jupiter = Moon/Venus (+1°52' S)

A warm-hearted and generous soul. Emotional and physical well-being. Giving and receiving. Enjoying life and all its pleasures - material comforts. Happiness and prosperity in love and partnership. Fulfilled expectations in emotional and

family life. Fertility. Nurturing and protective instincts; rewarding parenting. Successful creative ventures. Self-indulgence.

The Qualities and Elements

The signs of the zodiac are grouped into two basic categories. These are known as the Qualities and the Elements. The Qualities describe fundamental modes of activity and the Elements describe temperament. There are three Qualities: Cardinal, Fixed & Mutable and four Elements: Fire, Air, Earth & Water.
